(i.e., posture, breathing, expression) Student shows respect towards staff members, fellow students, and school equipment/property. Student is on task, free of distractions! (i.e., posture, breathing, expression) Student occasionally shows respect towards staff members, fellow students, and school equipment/property. Student is occasionally on task, and often distracted. (i.e., cell phone, iPad, homework, food)</p>

(Prepared is defined as being in assigned seat, having and using all assigned music, and the student's assigned instrument.) Student is rarely engaged throughout the rehearsal and demonstrates poor rehearsal discipline and technique. (i.e., posture, breathing, expression) Student rarely shows respect towards staff members, fellow students, and school equipment/property. Student is rarely on task, and often distracted. (i.e., cell phone, iPad, homework, food)</p>
